One growing area of liability exposure within the Catholic Church is related to driving and transportation activities. In an effort to reduce this exposure, the Diocese of Lexington requires all individuals who drive for the Church to take a defensive driving course prior to performing any driving duties. The following course takes less than 20 minutes to complete and training is free. As an added bonus, you may even be able to receive a discount on your personal auto insurance coverage. While Christ the King School is not currently requiring volunteer drivers to take this course, it is strongly suggested.
