Dear Christ the King School,

It is with a heavy heart that we must announce additional school closings. As was stated in the [Diocesan Epidemic Response Plan](#), released by the Catholic Diocese of Lexington, our Catholic schools will follow the recommendation of the Governor, health department, and local school districts.

The Governor has announced that out of an abundance of caution to help prevent community spread of COVID-19, all schools in Kentucky will remain closed until April 17, 2020. Tentatively, we will now plan to return to school on April 20, 2020.

Christ the King School will continue to utilize e-days between March 23-27, 2020 and again April 6-17, 2020. There will be no e-days held during our scheduled Spring Break (March 30, 2020-April 3, 2020) In addition, on Friday, April 10th, there will be no classes for Good Friday. If there are any changes to this timeframe, we will communicate that as soon as possible.

During the closure, there will be no athletic practices, games, extracurricular activities, events, etc. Communication regarding the Faith First Spring Soccer will be shared early next week. School-sponsored trips with students will be canceled or postponed. We will follow-up with additional communication. Out of protection for our families and employees, there will be no access to the facilities.

Please continue to pray for our school community and all those affected by this situation.
