As was stated in the Diocesan Epidemic Response Plan, released by the Catholic Diocese of Lexington, when closures occur, our Catholic schools will follow the recommendation of the Governor, health department, and local school districts.

Due to the continuing COVID-19 situation, the Governor has announced that all schools in Kentucky will remain closed until May 1, 2020. We are tentatively planning on returning to in-person classes on May 4, 2020. Christ the King will continue to utilize E-days between April 13, 2020 - May 1, 2020. Our goal is to continue to provide high-quality, electronic instruction. We are committed to the continuous educational growth of each student.

As stated earlier, there will be no E-Day Instruction held during our Spring Break (March 30, 2020-April 10, 2020.) Also, we will be reviewing and determining the next course of action concerning events between now and our return to school.
