Payment Options:

- 1. Payment in Full:** Due May 1, 2019 (tuition pay-in-full date)
- 2. Monthly Payment Option:** May, 2019, through April, 2020, payments paid through **FACTS**. Active FACTS accounts will rollover automatically to the new school year.

Tuition Policy

- Christ the King School tuition for monthly payments is due on the 5th or 20th day of each month, from May, 2019, through April, 2020, through your FACTS account.
- A late fee of \$25/month will be assessed to all accounts on which payment has not been received within 10 days after it is due.
- Parents with accounts past due 60 days must be brought current (zero past-due balance, which includes late fees) or they must meet with the Principal; parents may be asked to remove their child(ren) from the school enrollment due to non-payment.
- Once a student has been removed from the school's enrollment, a new application and application fee must be submitted, and the past-due account must be brought current before the student can be re-admitted.
